- ❖ You will be invited to put out your entries at a designated time on Saturday morning to ensure social distancing OR you may leave all your entries in a bag / box with the labels on Friday/ early Saturday morning for a steward to place for you.
- ❖ Judging of entries will take place – but only prize cards and best in section trophies will be awarded.
- ❖ Visitors to the show will be welcomed in the afternoon and will follow a one way system around the exhibits. Names and contact details will be recorded for Track and Trace if necessary.
