## SHOW RECIPE: APPLE SHORTCAKE

125g butter
125g caster sugar
125g self raising flour
125g plain flour
1 small egg
Apple puree
Sugar for sprinkling

Cream together butter and sugar, beat in egg and mix in both flours. Roll out mix into two 20cm circles. Put one circle in a greased sandwich tin. Top with a sweetened apple puree with a little cinnamon, top with other circle of dough, brush with water and sprinkle with sugar.

Bake 180C for 35-40mins until golden. Serve as a whole round.
